THE ANTHONY GRAINGER INQUIRY

DIRECTIONS ORDER
[26.7.16]

In this Order:

“the IPCC” means the Independent Police Complaints Commission
“GMP” means Greater Manchester Police
“Core Participants” means the core participants designated in this Inquiry by the Chairman

(1) Disclosure

1. In relation to the material provided to GMP by the Inquiry Team on **28.6.16** (“the IPCC’s sensitive unused material”), GMP shall identify to the Inquiry Team any proposed redactions on or before **23.8.16**.
2. In relation to the balance of the unused material obtained by the Inquiry Team from the IPCC:
 - a. The Inquiry Team shall disclose to GMP which of the material it regards as potentially relevant to the Inquiry’s Terms of Reference by **10.8.16**; and
 - b. GMP shall identify to the Inquiry Team of any proposed redactions by **8.9.16**

(2) Witness statements

3. The Inquiry Team shall use its best endeavours to send any requests for the provision of a witness statement pursuant to r9 of the Inquiry Rules 2006 by **31.8.16**.
4. Those in receipt of a request for a witness statement pursuant to r9 of the Inquiry Rules 2006 shall provide such a witness statement to Counsel to the Inquiry within 28 days of service of the request.

(3) Expert evidence

5. *Ballistics reconstruction*: The Inquiry shall instruct Dr Philip Seaman as an expert witness:
 - a. The Inquiry Team shall send to Core Participants a draft of a letter of instruction to Dr Seaman by **5.8.16**; and
 - b. Core Participants shall, if so advised, send to the Inquiry Team any additional issues which they suggest Dr Seaman should be asked to report on by **12.8.16**.

6. *Police command and control of firearms operation*: The Inquiry shall instruct a suitable expert witness in the command and control of police firearms operations:
 - a. The Inquiry Team shall send to Core Participants in the Inquiry a draft of a letter of instruction to such an expert by **12.8.16**; and
 - b. Core Participants shall, if so advised, send to the Inquiry Team any additional issues which they suggest the said expert should be asked to report on by **26.8.16**.

(4) Applications for anonymity and other protective measures

7. For the purpose of triggering any applications for anonymity or other protective measures, the Inquiry Team shall notify Core Participants of those witnesses (other than those witnesses mentioned in paragraph 3 above) who are likely to give evidence to the Inquiry at its oral hearings by **5.9.16**.

8. Any applications for anonymity or other protective measures in relation to those witnesses mentioned in paragraph 7 above shall be made within 21 days of notification in accordance with paragraph 7 above.

(5) Preliminary Hearing

9. There shall be a Preliminary Hearing on **14.11.16**.
